Natalie has enjoyed a 20 year nursing career working in sexual health and harm reduction in the Communicable Disease division of Toronto Public Health (TPH). In the early years she did sexually transmitted disease infection case management along with community sexual health promotion as well as working as a Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner at Women's College Hospital. Natalie received her Primary Care Nurse Practitioner certificate in 2003 from Ryerson. As a NP in TPH she provided clinical leadership skills in the Sexual Health Clinic program as well as the training of nurses in an expanded role capacity. In 2017 she was seconded to the Works Needle Exchange at TPH to develop a harm reduction focussed protocol and training for opiate overdose response for Ontario's first Health Canada sanctioned Supervised Injection Site. In recent years Natalie has become the SW Manager of TPH's Sexual Health Clinic program which is leading public health practice in the provision of pre-exposure prophylaxis (PrEP) for HIV by Public Health Nurses.
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
