>RNAO FAQ: RETIRED MEMBERS

- If you previously practised as a registered nurse or nurse practitioner and are now retired, you are eligible to register in this discounted category at \$87.83.
- If you are planning to practice nursing in retirement, the College of Nurses of Ontario (CNO) still required you to have PLP. This includes situations such as:
 - Occasional shift work.
 - Volunteer nursing.
 - o Camp nursing.
 - Teaching nursing knowledge/skill.
- Retired nurses can still benefit from RNAO member benefits, including professional liability protection (PLP). Members choosing this category receive PLP only if they maintain valid CNO registration in a class other than the non-practising class.
- Registration with the CNO is not a requirement for retired colleagues to continue to belong to RNAO and you can also join RNAO's <u>Retired Nurses Interest Group</u> to stay connected with your fellow retired nurses.
