Testing + COVID-19 Outbreaks	 NPs working in homes that have not yet seen a COVID-19 outbreak shared strategies for success: timely initiation of screening as per recommendations from MOHLTC limiting traffic into and out of the house as much as possible initiation of universal masking early on (before directive was released) strong leadership to close units, recreational programs, and advising families to stop visiting as soon as any residents have symptoms Question re: NPs being asked to sign LTC doctor's telephone orders while they are not able to come into the home. Answer: Avoid signing the doctor's orders as NPs can order their own. RNs are typically the ones to sign telephone orders from a physician, which the physician will need to physically sign later when they return to the facility. Suggestion to do virtual rounds with the physicians weekly.
