

BYLAWS COMMITTEE

The Bylaws Committee is a standing committee of the Board of Directors, with responsibility to annually review the Association's bylaws, consider recommendations for bylaw changes, and propose revisions to bylaws which are congruent with the Mission, Values and Ends of RNAO

FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS

Meetings will be held annually and at the call of the chair. Teleconference is the preferred choice of meeting. In-person meetings will be held as necessary.

PROVINCIAL NOMINATIONS COMMITTEE

To prepare and submit the Ticket of Nominations to the President and the Board of Directors.

FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS

As often as necessary in order to fulfil its responsibilities in accordance with timeframes specified in the Bylaws and Policies. Committee is responsible to keep within budget. Teleconference is the preferred choice but in-person meetings will be held as necessary.

PROVINCIAL RESOLUTIONS COMMITTEE

To work in accordance with policies and procedures established by the Board of Directors (BOD), to receive and prepare resolutions for presentation to the Annual Meeting.

FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS

Minimum of at least one meeting per year, prior to the Annual Meeting and at the call of the Chair. Teleconferenced meetings are the preferred choice. In-person meetings will be held if necessary.

Meetings will be one hour in length or more if required by the business at hand. However, the FIRST meeting of the committee after the resolution submission deadline, will be always be scheduled for 2 (two) hours.
